General	If a practice has no patients with the disease for a register, or in a sub-register for an indicator, can they claim for that indicator?	It has been agreed that there will be no payment for null registers so the answer is no in each of these circumstances.	June 2007
Medicines Management 7	If the Community Mental Health Team looks after a Practice's patients on injectable neuroleptic medication, can the Practice claim under this Indicator?	A Practices need to be part of the system for providing this service - they do not need to be giving the injections but they do have to have some responsibility for at least one patient during the year for making sure they get their jags. Thus, a practice where the local community mental health services take full responsibility for call and recall, follow-up, prescribing and giving the injections would not be eligible. However, one where the local CMHT expected Practices to chase people up, give jags opportunistically when they defaulted etc would be eligible.	12.04.06
Mental Health MH4 and 5	If a practice has no patients taking lithium are they able to achieve points for indicators MH3, MH4 and MH5.	The answer to this question is "No". If a practice does not have anyone on lithium treatment, their denominator for MH3, MH4 and MH5 will be nil so they will be unable to claim any points for these indicators.	June 2007
