<b>PC 3 Register</b>	<p>Practice would like to be able to remove patients from the Palliative Care register. At the moment once a patient is placed on the Palliative Care register they cannot be removed without deleting codes from the patient record. Practice feel it is inappropriate to delete some of the codes which should remain to form part of the patient history – particularly the referral codes, for example 8H7g Referral to Palliative Care service</p>	<p>If the code has been entered erroneously, especially if payment through QOF has been made, delete the code and make clear the justification for deletion in narrative in notes. On rare occasions, where patient has been placed on register as they had been expected to be palliative, and condition improves, and as numbers will be small suggest patient remains on register, with free text explaining why no longer palliative. The patient should then be reviewed as part of the register every three months to ensure that the patient requires no further intervention.</p>	<p>16/08/2010</p>
